A BILL TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF TELANGANA FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST APRIL, 2016.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Telangana in the Sixty-seventh year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

Short Title.

1. This Act may be called Telangana Appropriation Act (No. 1), 2016.

Appropriation of Rs.131033,78,25,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2016.

2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2016, a sum not exceeding one lakh thirty one thousand thirty three crores, seventy eight lakhs and twenty five thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet:-

(a) the grants made by the Telangana Legislative Assembly for that year, as set-forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana, for that year, as set-forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Telangana by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
