OATH OR AFFIRMATION

All the Hon'ble Members of the Second Telangana Legislative Assembly are informed that each Member has to make an Oath or Affirmation under Article 188 of the Constitution of India, before taking his/her seat in the House, besides another Oath, as required under Rule 5A of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Telangana Legislative Assembly.

Accordingly, the Members will make the Oath or Affirmation from 11.30 A.M. onwards on Thursday, the 17th January, 2019, before the Speaker Pro-tem in the Assembly Hall.

In connection with making the prescribed Oath or Affirmation, the Members are requested to carry without fail the Certificates of Election (Form 22) issued to them by the concerned Returning Officer under Rule 66 of the Conduct of Election Rules, 1961.

The following Procedure has been laid down for making the Oath or Affirmation:

"When the name of the Member is called by the Secretary to Legislature, the Member will proceed from the place of occupation to the right side of the Secretary's Table, where, copies of forms of Oath or Affirmation as the case may be, will be handed over to the Member on furnishing the Certificate of Election (Form 22). The Members have to take Oath or Affirmation as per the procedure set by the Constitution of India (Oath-I) and Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Telangana Legislative Assembly (Oath-II). The Member will face towards the Speaker Pro-tem while making the Oath or Affirmation and will then go upto the Speaker Pro-tem to extend the greetings and pursuant thereto, he will allow the Member to occupy the seat in the House. Then the Member shall move on from behind the chair of Speaker Pro-tem to the other side of the Table to sign the Roll of the Members. Thereafter, each Member will be given requisite Forms to be filled in and furnished to the Secretary to Legislature later and resume his/her seat in the House."
