All Members of the Telangana Legislative Assembly are informed that the Sixth Session of the Second Telangana Legislative Assembly is scheduled to commence at 11.00 A.M. on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2020. In this connection, the Hon'ble Speaker, Telangana Legislative Assembly has issued the following directions for smooth functioning of the House.

All the Ministers and Members are requested to co-operate by adhering to the following directions of the Hon'ble Speaker:

1. The Members are requested to undergo COVID-19 test and show the '**Negative Report**' while entering into the Legislature premises. Members are requested to cooperate with the staff in this regard.
2. Hon'ble Chief Minister and Ministers will enter the precincts through Gate No.I and the Members through Gate Nos.II and Gate No.IV.
3. Car Passes issued for the present Session should be displayed prominently on front wind screen of the vehicle to avoid any inconvenience at entry points.
4. All vehicles will be checked at **Gate Nos.I & II and Gate No.IV**. The Members are requested to cooperate with the Security personnel.
5. Self-Driven Vehicles of the Members will be allowed to enter the precincts through Gate II and Gate No.IV and those vehicles have to be parked at the designated place.
6. Chauffeur Driven vehicles will be allowed to enter the precincts through Gate II & Gate IV and those vehicles have to be parked in the Public Gardens after alighting at Entry No.IV (Members' entrance).
7. The Ministers and Members alone will be permitted into the Assembly Lobby.
8. Members shall leave their security personnel at the **Gunmen Point near Gate No.8**.
9. Members shall not bring weapons of any kind inside the Assembly Hall. They are requested to deposit them at the "**Bell of Arms**" provided near the Members' Service Counter before entering into the House.
10. Member are strictly prohibited to carrying of Fire arms, Banners, Lathis, Spears, Swords, Sticks, Brick Bats, Placards, etc.
11. Members shall not shout slogans, distribute pamphlets, leaflets and any other material in the precincts of the House.
12. Members are informed that Meetings, Processions, Demonstrations, Picketing and Dharna within the precincts of the Assembly are strictly prohibited.
13. Members are requested not to indulge in any activity which may cause or tend to cause inconvenience to other Members.
