

FEE REIMBURSEMENT SCHEME AND SCHOLARSHIPS
TO STUDENTS

Telangana Government decided to continue the implementation of Fee Reimbursement Scheme as it is in Telangana State also, which was started in United State. At the time of formation of Telangana State, the amount payable to the educational institutions towards Fee Reimbursement Scheme is Rs. 1880.97 crores. 6,843 educational institutions are getting Fee Reimbursement. Out of this, 1293 are Government educational institutions and 5550 are private educational institutions, i.e. out of total educational institutions, Government educational institutions are 18.90% and private educational institutions are 81.10%. Out of the total Fee Reimbursement, private educational institutions are receiving 90.18% and Government educational institutions are receiving 9.82% which is paid by the Government every year. The funds relating to Fee Reimbursement are released and disbursing from time to time. From the formation of Telangana State, Rs. 4687.72 crores of funds have been paid so far towards Fee Reimbursement.

We are well known that, recently the Central Government has taken the decision of demonetization of big notes. The impact of demonetization of big notes on the State's financial condition may be known in January only. Whatever happens, I am very glad to inform you that, Government is implementing this Scheme effectively for the welfare of poor students.
